

STEWARDSHIP

What is it? Using your time, talent, and treasures as an act of obedience and in response to what God has done for us and what we can do to further the Kingdom of God. We have a limited amount of time, talent and treasures, and are called to invest them into His Kingdom.

¹“Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven. ² “Thus, when you give to the needy, sound no trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be praised by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. ³ But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, ⁴ so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. Matthew 6:1-4, ESV

How Do I Steward?

1. Give to God _____ (Priority): Wherever we are using our time, talent and treasure first shows priority and value. God has called us to use these first to seek His kingdom and then all else will be added. Therefore, we should serve and give to the House of God first as an act of worship and obedience.
2. Give to God _____ (Percentage): We are called to be wise in how we handle our resources. The Bible speaks of the principle of tithing, which literally means 10%, as a means to manage our resources. Giving of our time/talent/treasures by percentage forces us to be wise stewards of the rest as it helps us to think in terms of budgeting. We need to budget our resources in what we are giving to God and how we are spending the rest.
